Health and Wellbeing Corner

Hi All,

Just a reminder of what we can assist you with in the clinic and any charges associated.
All Urgent Care is free.

Wound Care

Anything that is an accident we can dress for free as we are ACC accredited.
Dressings that need to be taken off after surgery or redressed incur a cost of \$5.00 a visit. If you have a dressing that the doctor has given you to use, then this service is free.
Suture removal incurs a cost of \$5.00 for our time.

Vit B12 injections

You will need to supply your ampule and then the cost is \$4.50 for the syringe and needle.
Other injections that you may require us to give is free if they come preloaded in their own syringe.

Medications

Any medications to be administered is \$5.00 a visit. If you require us to visit 4x daily then the maximum charge is \$15.00

Blood Pressure Readings

This is free but unless booked we may not have time to do this for you.

Aids

We can help set up aids that you may have including toilet frames, bedframes etc.

Advice

We are available for advice on any medical matters that you may want to discuss. This may also be about outside services that you can access, co-ordination for referrals etc.

What the clinic cannot provide

We provide First Response to all residents and then any ongoing care that may be needed as above. We do not have a contract to provide any personal cares such as toileting, showering etc but can assist in who to contact for this.

Remember that any Needs Assessment can be referred by yourself or your Next of Kin or your GP by ringing North Shore Hospital and asking for the Needs Assessors for Older People.
